

Learning Logs

What are learning logs?



- ▶ Firstly they are supposed to be **fun!**
- ▶ It is the children's way to show you what they have learnt at school that week.
- ▶ You can be as creative as you want with the activities.
- ▶ No learning log will look the same.
- ▶ You can write, draw a picture, take a picture or make a model etc.

Information:

- ▶ The children have 1 sticker to complete each week.
- ▶ It could be maths, literacy, understanding the world based.
- ▶ This can be completed however you like.
- ▶ They are handed out on a Friday and need to be returned on a Wednesday
- ▶ Even if you haven't completed the task please still hand in the learning log for the next sticker.
- ▶ The learning logs will also contain the 'words of the week' that the children have learnt that week.
 - ▶ Please go through these words with the children and ask them to explain what they mean.
- ▶ If you have any questions about these, please speak to Miss Marshall who will be able to help.

Examples

- ▶ This week our sticker is: I can identify some of the organs in the body.
- ▶ Some ideas to complete this are:
 - ▶ Drawing/ painting a body and labelling it.
 - ▶ Drawing/ painting an organ and writing a sentence about what it does.
 - ▶ Taking a photo of yourself and labelling the organs.
 - ▶ Creating a model of a organ or body.
